#### FEES REGULATIONS

- 1. Students who want to join any other Professional of Technical Courses or Institutions offering a different courses etc, should need to apply for refund on or before the admission procedure is closed by M.G.University. However, College fees will be levied.
- 2. Semester fees will be collected in lumpsum at the beginning for the year or in instalments per semester.
- 3. Fee should be remitted before the Tenth Working day of the beginning of the each semester. Defaulters will have to pay the fees with fine of rupees 5/- within one month from the due date. Rupees 10/- within 2 months (60 days) from the due date and rs.25/- within three months (90 days).
- 4. In the case of those who do not even remit their fee with fine within the last chance ie, within three months from the due date of fee for semester their names will be removed from the rolls and they will lose their attendance which will be disqualification for writing their exams.
- 5. No TC will be issued to those who owe fees due to the college.
- 6. Fees once paid will not be refunded

#### **RULES FOR ADMISSION**

- 1. Application for admission to the UG programme in the Management Quota, shall be made in the prescribed form from the Management Office or online on payment of Rs. 100/-.
- 2. Application Number must be quoted in all subsequent correspondence. The Application for Degree/PG programme duly filled in should reach the Management office on or before the last date published by the University. CAP registered form should be submitted with the application form.
- 3. Application containing false information will be rejected.
- 4. Eligible candidate will be called for an interview for which they should appear, accompanied by their parent or guardian with all their Original certificates. Considering the present scenario of Covid-19, the candidate should report at the college as per the instructions of the University.
- 5. All columns in the application form must be carefully filled in. Self attestation of marks shall be made in appropriate pages. Non compliance of the same will entail rejection of the application.
- 6. Candidates who have passed their qualifying exam from Universities /Institutions outside the state will be admitted on production of Eligibility Certificate from the Mahatma Gandhi University.
- 7. Applicants are advised to keep with them sufficient number of True copies of their Certificates and the Marklist before they submit the original at the Management Office.
- 8. Candidates belonging to the SC/ST/OEC/FM are Eligible for fees concession only if they are admitted on merit basis.
- 9. Students admitted through Management Quota are not eligible for any fee Concession.

# 10. Documents to be Produced at the Time of Admission:

- > The Allotment Memo received online.
- X Std. Certificate to prove Date of birth- 2 copies.
- Mark lists of all parts of the Plus Two / Degree/equivalent examination.
- > Transfer Certificate (TC) from the Institution last attended and Conduct Certificate.
- Address proof Copy (Aadhar Card)
- Recently taken Passport size photographs 3 Nos.
- > Migration Certificate in the case of students passed from any other Universities.
- Eligibility Certificate from Mahatma Gandhi University, in the case of candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from other Boards/Institutes/governments, except BOARD OF HIGHER SECONDARY EDUCATION Kerala, VHSE Kerala, THSE Kerala, CBSE and CISCE.
- Caste certificate in the case of those who claim for fee concession.
- Candidates who wish to avail of bonus/weightage of marks shall produce the relevant certificates.
- 11. Identity Card must be with the students whenever he/she is in the campus and should be produced on demand by any member of the staff. This card should be returned to the college office when the student leaves the college after the tenure of his/her studies.
- 12. All Guardians are expected to join Parent Teacher Association of the College, which is formed for the maintenance of general discipline in the college and progress of students.
